

Annual Visit appointment checklist for cats over 6 months.

Treatment	Why Is This Important?
Physical Exam	Required yearly by the state to treat or prescribe for your pet. A nose to tail exam is the best way to ensure your pet's health.
Rabies Vaccination	Required by the state to be given by a licensed veterinarian. Rabies is fatal to pets and people.
Rabies Tag	Proof of rabies vaccination on years vaccine not given
FVRCP Vaccine	This core vaccine protects against a combination of common feline diseases.
Calicivirus Vaccine	This core vaccine protects against a very contagious disease that is easily spread.
Leukemia Vaccine	This social vaccine protects against a usually fatal disease spread by other cats.
Intestinal Parasite and Giardia Test	Screens for intestinal parasites that can cause disease including severe diarrhea in people, and blindness in children.
Leukemia/FIV Test	Screens for contagious, serious feline diseases.
Wellness Blood Test	Detects early signs of organ dysfunction with a blood test. This is a great way to catch health issue before they are evident by symptoms. Begin around 4 years for yearly monitoring. Pet should be fasted ideally for 12 hours.
Urinalysis	Checks for infections, stones, cancer, and kidney disease. Begin around 4 years old.
Genetic DNA & Breed Test	Breed information and DNA screening test for several serious conditions such as heart disease, bladder stones, or stomatitis.
Parasite Protection	Prevents intestinal parasites, heartworm disease and fleas.
Topical	Monthly heartworm, flea, tick, ear mite, rounds/hooks.
Wearable	Collar for fleas and ticks that lasts 8 months.
